THE DAIRY PRODUCE REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT NO. 32

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Industry Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 32, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of June 1977.
- 2. Dairy produce grading levy—The Dairy Produce Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3 are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8, and substituting the following regulation:
- "8. For the purpose of defraying the cost of grading butter and cheese, every owner shall, subject to the provisions hereinafter contained, be charged with an annual levy, computed on the total number of the kilograms of the product concerned manufactured by the owner during any financial year disclosed by the accounts and balance sheet of the owner for that year, at the following rates:
 - (a) In respect of butter and whey butter, 0.3573c per kilogram:
 - (b) In respect of cheese, 0.1667c per kilogram:
 - (c) In respect of anhydrous milkfat, 0.085c per kilogram."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations increase the dairy produce grading levies for butter (including whey butter), cheese, and anhydrous milkfat to 0.3573c, 0.1667c and 0.085c per kilogram respectively from 1 June 1977.
