THE DAIRY PRODUCE SUPERANNUATION LEVY REGULATIONS 1952

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 26th day
of November 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 3 of the Dairy Produce Amendment Act 1952, His
Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the
advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following
regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952.
2. The amount of the special levies that may be imposed under section 3 of the Dairy Produce Amendment Act 1952 on butter and cheese manufactured for sale shall not exceed—
 - (a) In the case of butter 0.036d. per pound; and
 - (b) In the case of cheese 0.018d. per pound.
3. The methods to be adopted in the collection of those levies shall be those prescribed for the collection of levies under the Dairy Produce Levy Regulations 1948,* and the provisions of those regulations shall, with the necessary modifications, apply accordingly.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations prescribe the maximum amount of the special levies on butter and cheese that may be imposed on dairy companies as a contribution towards a superannuation scheme for their employees.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.
