THE DAIRY PRODUCE SUPERANNUATION LEVY **REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Board Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by repealing regulation 2, and substituting the following regulation:

"2. The amount of the special levies that may be imposed under section 15 of the Dairy Board Act 1953 on butter and cheese manufactured for sale shall not, in respect of any period after the 1st day of August 1957, exceed—

'(a) In the case of butter 0.06d. per pound; and

"(b) In the case of cheese 0.03d. per pound."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations prescribe the maximum amount of the special levies on butter and cheese that may be imposed on dairy companies as a contribution towards a superannuation scheme for their employees.
