THE DAIRY PRODUCE SUPERANNUATION LEVY REGULATIONS 1952, AMENDMENT NO. 3

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dairy Board Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Special levies on butter and cheese—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by repealing regulation 2 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2), and substituting the following regulation:

"2. The amount of the special levies that may be imposed under section 45 of the Dairy Board Act 1961 on butter and cheese manufactured for sale shall not, in respect of any period after the commencement of these regulations, exceed—

"(a) In the case of butter 0.080c per pound; and

"(b) In the case of cheese 0.040c per pound."

(2) The Dairy Produce Superannuation Levy Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 2, are hereby consequentially revoked.
