ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 22nd day of June 1987

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 9 of the Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges (Tuvalu Trust Fund) Order 1987.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Declaration as to organisation—The Tuvalu Trust Fund (in this order called the Fund), established by the Agreement Concerning an International Trust Fund for Tuvalu done at Suva on the 16th day of June 1987, is hereby declared to be an organisation of which the Governments of 2 or more States are members.
- **3. Body corporate**—The Fund shall have the legal capacities of a body corporate.

4. Exemption from direct taxes—The Fund shall be exempt from direct taxes.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that the Tuvalu Trust Fund is to have the legal capacities of a body corporate, and is to be exempt from the payment of direct taxes.
