



## THE DIPLOMATIC PRIVILEGES WITHDRAWAL ORDER 1976

PURSUANT to the Diplomatic Privileges and Immunities Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Diplomatic Privileges Withdrawal Order 1976.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1976.

**2. Revocations**—The Diplomatic Privileges (CULSOCEN) Order 1970\*, the Diplomatic Privileges (FFTC) Order 1970†, and the Diplomatic Privileges (ECOCEN) Order 1970‡ are hereby revoked.

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order withdraws, as from 1 July 1976, diplomatic privileges and immunities granted in respect of 3 regional centres set up under the auspices of the Asian and Pacific Council. On that date New Zealand's withdrawal from the Council takes effect.
