**THE DENTAL REGULATIONS 1937, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of  
November 1951

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dentists Act 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the following Schedule:—

3. The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (2) of Form No. 3 in the First Schedule, and substituting the following paragraph:—

“(2) Fee of £5. [*If fee paid by cheque, add exchange where necessary.*]”
