THE DIETITIANS REGULATIONS 1953, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of June 1968

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dietitians Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dietitians Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dietitians Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1968.

2. Fees—(1) Regulation 17 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 8 of the Dietitians Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 1 and by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby further amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (3) the figure “\$6”, and substituting the figure “\$10”;

(b) By omitting from subclause (6) the figure “\$1”, and substituting the figure “\$2”.

(2) Notwithstanding the amendment made to regulation 17 of the principal regulations by paragraph (b) of subclause (1) of this regulation the fee payable by any dietitian for the issue of an annual practising certificate in respect of the year beginning on the 1st day of March 1968 shall be \$1.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Dietitians Regulations 1953 by increasing the fee payable by an applicant for registration as a dietitian from \$6 to \$10, and the fee payable for the issue of an annual practising certificate from \$1 to \$2. The new fees come into force on 1 October 1968 but the fee payable for the issue of a practising certificate for the year that commenced with 1 March 1968 is not affected.
