PURSUANT to the Dietitians Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dietitians Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dietitians Regulations 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Prerequisite qualifications for student dietitians—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Dietitians Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b) of subclause (1).

(2) Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 4 of the Dietitians Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 1) is hereby consequentially amended by revoking paragraph (b) of subclause (1).

(3) Regulation 4 of the Dietitians Regulations 1953, Amendment No. 1, is hereby consequentially amended by revoking paragraph (c) of subclause (1).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Dietitians Regulations 1953. At present paragraph (b) of subclause (1) of regulation 3 provides that a person may be accepted as a student dietitian if she is a registered nurse who is the holder of an endorsed School Certificate or of such other certificate, whether granted in New Zealand or elsewhere, as is, in the opinion of the Board, substantially equivalent thereto. This paragraph is revoked so that in future no person may be accepted as a student dietitian unless she holds an appropriate degree or diploma in Home Science, or a degree or diploma substantially equivalent thereto.
