THE DESIGNS REGULATIONS 1954, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of December 1966

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Designs Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Designs Regulations 1954, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Designs Regulations 1954* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking items 4 and 5, and substituting the following items:

"Item	Subject or Proceeding	Amount	Corresponding Form No.
4	On application for the extension of copyright under section 12 (2) of the Act for second period	£ s. d. 3 0 0	12
5	On application for the extension of copyright under section 12 (2) of the Act for third period	6 0 0	13".

(2) This regulation shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1967.

3. (1) The fee payable in respect of any application for extension of copyright for the immediately following period (if any) pursuant to section 12 of the Designs Act 1953 shall be the fee that would have been payable if regulation 2 of these regulations had not come into force in any case where—

(a) The current period of copyright expires on or before the 31st day of March 1967; or

(b) The application for extension of copyright for the period was made and the fee paid before the date of the notification of these regulations in the *Gazette*.

(2) Subject to subclause (1) of this regulation, where the current period of registration expires on or after the 1st day of April 1967, the fee payable in respect of any application for extension of copyright for any subsequent period pursuant to section 12 of the Designs Act 1953 shall be the fee that would be payable if regulation 2 of these regulations had come into force before the making of the application and the payment of the fee.

4. Where any doubt or uncertainty arises as to whether any fee for the extension of copyright under the said section 12 that is payable on or before the 31st day of March 1969 is payable at the higher rate payable after regulation 2 of these regulations comes into force or at the lower rate payable before that regulation comes into force, the Commissioner may, if he thinks fit, accept payment at the lower rate in full satisfaction of the fee payable.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fees payable for an extension of the term of copyright made in terms of section 12 of the Designs Act 1953.
