THE DISTILLATION (FEES) REGULATIONS 1960

COBHAM, Governor-General

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 6th day of December 1960

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Distillation Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Distillation (Fees) Regulations 1960.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1961.

2. There shall be paid to the Collector of Customs in respect of every licence to distil spirits for fortifying New Zealand wine and every licence to distil any liquid or substance other than spirits the annual licence fees referred to in the Schedule hereto.
