THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL, PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dental Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1969.

2. Forms—The First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Form 7 and substituting the form set out in the First Schedule hereto.

3. New Second Schedule substituted—(1) The principal regulations, as amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964, are hereby further amended by revoking the Second Schedule and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Second Schedule hereto.

(2) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of this regulation the fee for an annual practising certificate in respect of the year commencing on the 1st day of June 1968 shall be \$2.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Dental Regulations 1964 by substituting a new form 7 for application for registration, and by increasing the following fees:

- (a) Certificate of registration—from \$1 to \$2:
- (b) Provisional practising certificate—from 50c to \$1:
- (c) Annual practising certificate—from \$2 to \$3:
- (d) Inspection of the register—from 50c to \$1.

The new fees come into force on 1 April 1969, but the fee payable for the issue of a practising certificate for the year that commenced with 1 June 1968 is not affected.
