PURSUANT to section 54 (f) of the Dental Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Election of members of council—Regulation 3 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “Director-General” and substituting the words “Chairman of the Dental Council”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations to provide that the Chairman of the Dental Council shall fix the date for elections to the Council rather than the Director-General of Health. The amendment is consequential upon the 1971 amendment to the Dental Act 1963 which provided for the appointment of an independent Secretary to the Council in place of a public servant.
