ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 18th day of April 1977

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. B. E. TALBOYS PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dental Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1977.

2. New Second Schedule substituted—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1 and amended by regulation 2 of the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 2) and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 3 of the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 1, and the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.
