ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to paragraphs (c) and (d) of section 54 of the Dental Act 1963 (as amended by section 3 of the Dental Amendment Act 1968), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. New Second Schedule substituted—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 5), and

substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subclause (1) of this regulation, the fee payable for an annual practising certificate in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of May 1988 shall be \$15.
- **3. Goods and services tax included**—The fees prescribed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.
- **4. Revocation**—The Dental Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 5 are hereby consequentially revoked.
