

THE DISTILLATION REGULATIONS 1977, AMENDMENT NO. 2

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Distillation Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. **Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Distillation Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Distillation Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- **2. First Schedule**—(1) The First Schedule to the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 8 of the Distillation Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting from Form 2, in both places where they occur, the words:

"Minister

Comptroller Director

of Customs",

(Inland Services Division) and substituting the words:
"Minister/Minister's Delegate".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 makes two minor amendments to Forms 2 and 3 as to the persons authorised to issue and renew licences under the Distillation Act 1971.
