### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 22nd day of September 1986

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Distillation Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Distillation Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Distillation Regulations 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

**2. Revocations**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 8 (as substituted by regulation 3 (1) of the Distillation Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1), regulation 10, and the Second Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 3 (2) of the Distillation Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1).

(2) The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting form 3 from the Second Schedule.

(3) The Distillation Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1 are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force on 1 October 1986,—

(a) Abolish the fees payable for a licence:

(b) Remove the requirement for the renewal of licences.

These matters are now dealt with under the Customs Act 1966, following the new provisions for licensing under that Act, as inserted by the Customs Amendment Act 1986.
