



## THE DIETITIANS REGULATIONS 1975, AMENDMENT NO. 3

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 32 of the Dietitians Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

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### REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dietitians Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dietitians Regulations 1975\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.

**2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term “hospital”, and substituting the following definition:

“‘Hospital’ means a hospital or other institution controlled or maintained by an Area Health Board, Hospital Board, or Department of State.”

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations are consequential upon the Area Health Boards Act 1983. The definition of the term "hospital" is extended to include a hospital or other institution controlled or maintained by an Area Health Board.
