PURSUANT to section 32 of the Dietitians Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dietitians Regulations 1975, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dietitians Regulations 1975* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.
- **2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definition of the term "hospital", and substituting the following definition:
 - "'Hospital' means a hospital or other institution controlled or maintained by an Area Health Board, Hospital Board, or Department of State:".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations are consequential upon the Area Health Boards Act 1983. The definition of the term "hospital" is extended to include a hospital or other institution controlled or maintained by an Area Health Board.
