



THE DIETITIANS REGULATIONS 1987, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 29th day of May 1989

THE RIGHT HON. G. W. R. PALMER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 32 (2) (e) of the Dietitians Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dietitians Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dietitians Regulations 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1989.

2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 20 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Dietitians Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the following regulation:

“20. (1) The fee for admission to the State Examination for Dietitians shall be \$135.00.

“(2) The fee for re-examination shall be \$135.00 for each paper in which the applicant is re-examined.

“(3) The fee for an application for registration shall be \$67.50 except in the case of an application for registration by an applicant who is registered as a dietitian in any other country and temporarily employed in a hospital in New Zealand on exchange for not more than 12 months with a dietitian who is registered in New Zealand and similarly employed in that other country, in which case no fee shall be payable under this subclause.

“(4) The fee for the issue of a certificate of registration shall be \$22.50.

“(5) The fee for the issue of a certificate of temporary registration shall be \$45.00.

“(6) The fee for the restoration of a name to the register, pursuant to an application under section 16 (4) of the Act, shall be \$39.38.

“(7) The fee for the issue of an annual practising certificate shall be \$90.

“(8) The fee for the correction of a name in the register, pursuant to an application under section 18 (2) of the Act, shall be \$11.25.”

3. Fees inclusive of goods and services tax—The fees fixed by these regulations are inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

4. Revocation—The Dietitians Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 July 1989, prescribe a new and increased scale of fees payable under the Dietitians Act 1950, to reflect the increase in goods and services tax.
