PURSUANT to section 83 of the Dental Act 1988, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the advice of the Minister of Health given after consultation by the Minister with the Dental Technicians Board, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Regulations 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
 - (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1996.
- 2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking Part II of the Schedule (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Dental Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 6), and substituting the new Part II set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1996, prescribe a new scale of fees payable to the Dental Technicians Board.

The fee payable on application for registration as a dental technician or clinical dental technician has been restructured to distinguish between applicants relying on New Zealand qualifications, and those relying on overseas qualifications. The existing fee is \$160 for both classes of applicant. New Zealand trained applicants will now pay a fee of \$120, and overseas trained applicants will pay a fee of \$200.

Other fees have been increased, except for the fee for a certificate of temporary registration (which has been reduced), and the fee for a provisional certificate (which has been abolished).

The fees prescribed are inclusive of goods and services tax.
