DEFINING RIVER, EXTENDED RIVER, AND EXTREME LIMITS

Marine Department, Wellington, 6th November, 1950.

Pursuant to section 189 of the Shipping and Seamen Act, 1908, I, William Stanley Goosman, Minister of Marine, do hereby amend the Warrant dated the 7th day of November, 1949, defining river, extended river, and extreme limits* as follows:—

(a) By adding to the entry in the third column of the Schedule headed "Extended-river and Partially Smooth-water Limits" relating to the Port of Mangonui the following words:— "Seasonal: For vessels engaged in deep sea sports fishing only:—

From 1st May to 31st October: Within a radius of 13 miles from Cone Rock.

From 1st November to 30th April: Within a radius of 20 miles from Cone Rock":

(b) By omitting the words in the third column of the Schedule headed "Extended-river and Partially Smooth-water Limits" relating to the Port of Nelson, and substituting the following words: "Southward of a right line drawn from Separation Point at the south-eastern part of Golden Bay to Twobay Point, the north-eastern entrance point of Greville (or Brooke) Harbour, and from Sauvage Point to Okuri Point."
