**THE DEEDS REGISTER OFFICE AMENDING
REGULATIONS 1957**

—

PURSUANT to the Deeds Registration Act 1908, the Registrar-General of Land hereby makes the following regulations.

—

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Deeds Register Office Amending Regulations 1957, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the regulations made under the Deeds Registration Act 1908 on the 27th day of February 1914* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 2 (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Deeds Register Office Regulations 1949†), the following regulation:

“2A. (1) In regulation 2 of these regulations the term ‘holidays’ includes—

“(a) Any day falling during the period commencing on the 25th day of December and ending with the 2nd day of January:

“(b) Where the 2nd day of January falls on a Saturday, the 4th day of January:

“(c) Where the 2nd day of January falls on a Sunday, the 3rd and 4th days of January:

“(d) Good Friday:

“(e) Easter Monday:

“(f) Anzac Day:

“(g) The Sovereign’s birthday:

“(h) The holiday observed in the locality as Anniversary Day:

“(i) Labour Day.

“(2) Every day which is a holiday within the meaning of regulation 2 of these regulations shall, in relation to any instrument or document that is required to be registered or deposited in the Deeds Register Office or with the Registrar of Deeds, be deemed to be a holiday within the meaning of paragraph (a) of section 25 of the Acts Interpretation Act 1924 (which relates to the extension of the time for doing anything where the time prescribed in that behalf expires on a holiday).”
