## THE DOGS REGISTRATION REGULATIONS 1955

# C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 7th day of December 1955

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Dogs Registration Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Dogs Registration Regulations 1955.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1956.
- 2. (1) The register required by section 6 of the Dogs Registration Act 1955 to be kept by the local authority at each registration office for its district shall be in form 1 in the Schedule hereto.
- (2) The register shall be kept in book form, or in such other form as the local authority decides.
- 3. The declaration required by section 8 (3) of the said Act to be signed by a person claiming to register a dog as a working dog shall be in form 2 in the Schedule hereto.

#### FORM 2

DECLARATION ON APPLICATION TO REGISTER DOG AS A WORKING DOG

I, [Full Name], of, [Address], being the owner of a dog (or [Number] dogs), which I apply to have registered as (a) working dog(s) under section 8 of the Dogs Registration Act 1955, hereby solemnly and sincerely declare-

[Or, where application is made for registration of dogs as working dogs pursuant to a resolution of the local authority under section 8 (5)

That I am a [State occupation] and the said dog(s) is (are) kept by me solely for the purpose of State purpose in conformity with the resolution of the local authority].

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the form of the Register of Dogs to be kept by local authorities for the purposes of the Dogs Registration Act 1955 and the form of declaration to be completed by persons claiming to register dogs as working dogs.
