DECLARATION ON APPLICATION TO REGISTER DOG AS A WORKING DOG  
I, [Full Name], of, [Address], being the owner of a dog (or [Number] dogs), which I apply to have registered as (a) working dog(s) under section 8 of the Dogs Registration Act 1955, hereby solemnly and sincerely declare—

That I am a shepherd (or drover) (or farmer) and that the said dog(s) is (are) owned by me and kept solely for the purpose of herding or driving sheep or cattle.

[Or, in the case of dogs owned by a Rabbit Board]

That I am the Secretary to the [Name] Rabbit Board and the said dog(s) is (are) owned by the Board and kept solely for the purpose of destroying rabbits.

[Or, in the case of dogs owned by a rabbitier employed by a Rabbit Board]

That I am a rabbitier employed by the [Name] Rabbit Board and the said dog(s) is (are) owned by me and kept solely for the purpose of destroying rabbits.

[Or, where application is made for registration of dogs as working dogs pursuant to a resolution of the local authority under section 8 (5) of the Act]

That I am a [State occupation] and the said dog(s) is (are) kept by me solely for the purpose of [State purpose in conformity with the resolution of the local authority].

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations prescribe the form of the Register of Dogs to be kept by local authorities for the purposes of the Dogs Registration Act 1955 and the form of declaration to be completed by persons claiming to register dogs as working dogs.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 8 December 1955.
