



THE DRUG TARIFF 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to the Social Security Act 1938, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following direction.

1. (1) This direction may be cited as the Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Drug Tariff 1960.*

(2) This direction shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1960.

2. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto included the medicines, drugs, and materials specified in the First Schedule hereto and as if they were available to the extent specified in the said First Schedule.

3. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto were amended by omitting the items having the code references shown in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, and substituting the items set out in the said Second Schedule.
