

THE DRUG TARIFF 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 3

Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1938, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following direction.

- 1. (1) This direction may be cited as the Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Drug Tariff 1960.*
- (2) This direction shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1961.
- 2. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if subclause (3) of clause 18 were omitted, and the following headings and clauses were substituted therefor:

"Diagnostic Solution-tablets of Copper

"18A. Payment for the supply of diagnostic solution-tablets of copper shall be computed on the basis of cost price, plus 20 per cent of the cost price, plus dispensing fees.

"Opaque Media Preparations

- "18B. Payment in respect of the several forms of opaque media allowed under this Drug Tariff shall be made on the basis of the cost price of opaque media as approved from time to time by the Price Tribunal, plus 20 per cent."
- 3. Clause 2 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if—
 - (a) The words "or one repeat" were omitted, and the words "and one repeat" were substituted therefor;
 - (b) The words "(including any such repeat)" were inserted after the word "supply"; and
 - (c) The words "or congenital heart disease" were inserted after the words "rheumatic diseases".
- 4. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto included the medicines, drugs, and materials specified in the First Schedule hereto and as if they were available to the extent specified in the said First Schedule.
- 5. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto were amended by omitting the items having the code references shown in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, and substituting the items set out in the said Second Schedule.

- **6.** Part II of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the items specified in the Third Schedule hereto were omitted.
- 7. The Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 2, is hereby revoked; and the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if this direction was the only amendment thereof that had ever been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the direction, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This direction amends the Drug Tariff 1960 so as to make minor alterations in the rules for pricing and in the effect of a penicillin restriction, and so as to provide for additions to and alterations in the list of medicines, drugs, and materials in Part II of the Schedule.

Trade names of drugs that are included in the Drug Tariff for the first time are:

Depo-Medrol Methylprednisolone acetate for intraarticular injection. Distaval (Hospital Board) Thalidomide. Framycort Eye/Ear drops and eye ointment (E.N.T. and eye specialist) Framycetin sulphate and hydrocortisone acetate. Framycort Lotion and Ointment (part Framycetin sulphate and hydrocortisone charge) acetate. Glaucon (Hospital Board, ophthalmological specialist) Laevo-adrenaline hydrochloride. Aluminium hydroxide gel and Kaolin Kaomagma P with pectin mixture. Ledercort Parenteral (Hospital Board Triamcinolone diacetate. special committee) Mysteclin V Improved (Antibiotic Tetracycline hydrochloride and amphorestriction) tericin-B. Navidrex-Serpasil-K Cyclopenthiazide and reserpine with potassium chloride. Predsol Retention Enema (Hospital Prednisolone disodium phosphate. Board) Pripsen (part charge) Piperazine phosphate and senna extract, standardised. Stelazine (Hospital Board) Trifluoperazine.
