THE DRUG TARIFF 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 4

Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1938, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following direction.

- 1. (1) This direction may be cited as the Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Drug Tariff 1960.*
 - (2) This direction shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1962.
- **2.** Subclause (3) of clause 11 of the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the words "opaque media preparations" were inserted after the words "clinitest tablets".
- **3.** The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if subclause (3) of clause 18 were omitted, and the following headings and clauses were substituted therefor:

"Diagnostic Solution-tablets of Copper

"18A. Payment for the supply of diagnostic solution-tablets of copper shall be computed on the basis of cost price, plus 20 per cent of the cost price, plus dispensing fees.

"Opaque Media Preparations

- "18B. Payment in respect of the several forms of opaque media allowed under this Drug Tariff shall be made on the basis of the cost price of opaque media as approved from time to time by the Price Tribunal, plus 20 per cent."
- **4.** Clause 1 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if paragraph (c) was revoked, and the following paragraph was substituted therefor:
 - "(c) Any proprietary topical application other than a preparation that is specified in Part II of this Schedule is not a charge on the Fund. Likewise the quantity (if any) of the following materials, their salts and derivatives, present in any extemporaneously dispensed preparation, being other than a preparation specified in Part II of this Schedule, is not a charge on the Fund:

Chloramphenicol: Chlortetracycline: Erythromycin: Oxytetracycline: Tetracycline."

- 5. Clause 2 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1950 shall be read as if—
 - (a) The words "or one repeat" were omitted, and the words "and one repeat" were substituted therefor;
 - (b) The words "(including any such repeat)" were inserted after the word "supply"; and
 - (c) The words "or congenital heart disease" were inserted after the words "rheumatic diseases".
- **6.** Clause 3 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the following proviso was added thereto:
- "Provided that, in the case of continuation treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by (*Name of specialist*)' shall be accepted for payment."
- 7. Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the following clauses were inserted after clause 7:
- "7A. 'Hospital Board (dermatological specialist)' means that the material concerned may be supplied to a person, who is not the inmate of a public hospital, on the recommendation of a dermatological specialist:
- "Provided that, in the case of continuation treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by (Name of specialist)' shall be accepted for payment.
- "7B. 'Hospital Board (psychiatric specialist)' means that the material concerned may be supplied to a person, who is not the inmate of a public hospital or a mental hospital, on the recommendation of a psychiatric specialist:
- "Provided that, in the case of continuation treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by (*Name of specialist*)' shall be accepted for payment."
- 8. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto included the medicines, drugs, and materials specified in the First Schedule hereto and as if they were available to the extent specified in the said First Schedule.
- 9. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto were amended by omitting the items having the code references shown in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, and substituting the items set out in the said Second Schedule.
- 10. Part II of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the items specified in the Third Schedule hereto were omitted.
- 11. The Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 3, is hereby revoked; and the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if this direction was the only amendment thereof that had ever been made.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the direction, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This direction amends the Drug Tariff 1960 so as to make minor alterations in the rules for pricing and in the definitions in Part I of the Schedule, and so as to provide for additions to and alterations in the list of medicines, drugs, and materials in Part II of the Schedule.

Trade names of drugs that are included in the Drug Tariff for the first time are:
