THE DRUG TARIFF 1960, AMENDMENT NO. 6

Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1938, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following direction.

- 1. (1) This direction may be cited as the Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Drug Tariff 1960.*
 - (2) This direction shall come into force on the 1st day of May 1963.
- 2. Clause 2 of the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the definition of the term "Prescription Pricing Schedules" were omitted, and the following definition were substituted therefor:
 - "'Prescription Pricing Schedules' means the Official Schedules for Prescription Pricing issued by the Department of Health from time to time:".
- 3. The proviso to clause 3 of the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if—
 - (a) The words "Contraceptive preparations" were omitted, and the words "Preparations prescribed for contraceptive purposes" were substituted therefor:
 - (b) The following words were added:

"Aerosols and similar articles packed under pressure other than a preparation (if any) that is specified in Part II of the Schedule to this Drug Tariff."

- **4.** Clause 5 of the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if subclause (3) were omitted, and the following subclause were substituted therefor:
- "(3) Nothing in this Drug Tariff or in the said regulations shall be construed so as to prohibit a contractor from charging a customer with the price of any goods, not being pharmaceutical requirements, that are supplied by him, or with the price of any pharmaceutical requirements that are supplied by him in excess of the maximum quantities specified in this Drug Tariff, or with any excess of the price of any goods over the amount payable from the Fund, when calculated in accordance with clause 13 of the regulations and the prescription pricing rules and Schedules specified in this Drug Tariff."

- **5.** Clause 7 of the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if paragraph (c) of subclause (1) were omitted, and the following paragraph were substituted therefor:
 - "(c) Where the materials supplied on a medical prescription are supplied in a dropper-bottle, metal tube, or other approved container, the sum from time to time specified in the Second Schedule to the Prescription Pricing Schedules (in addition to the average container charge):".
- 6. Subclause (3) of clause 11 of the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the words "opaque media preparations" were inserted after the words "clinitest tablets".
- 7. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if subclause (3) of clause 18 were omitted, and the following headings and clauses were substituted therefor:

"Diagnostic Solution-tablets of Copper

"18A. Payment for the supply of diagnostic solution-tablets of copper shall be computed on the basis of cost price, plus 20 per cent of the cost price, plus dispensing fees.

"Opaque Media Preparations

- "18B. Payment in respect of the several forms of opaque media allowed under this Drug Tariff shall be made on the basis of the cost price of opaque media as approved from time to time by the Price Tribunal, plus 20 per cent."
- 8. Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if clause 1 were revoked, and the following clause were substituted therefor:
 - "1. (1) 'Antibiotic restriction' means—
 - "(a) Supplied pursuant to a prescription ordered for the treatment of an infection—

"(i) Where the infection is resistant to penicillin or

sulphonamides; or

- (ii) Where a broad spectrum antibiotic is regarded by authoritative medical opinion as the treatment of choice for the infection; and
- "(b) Restricted as to the quantity which may be supplied as pursuant to any one medical prescription so that-

"(i) In the case of capsules or tablets, the quantity for which payment may be made from the Fund pursuant to any one medical prescription shall not exceed a total of 16 capsules or tablets in respect of the original prescription,

together with a repeat, if any:

"(ii) In the case of oral suspensions, paediatric drops, or other preparations (other than capsules or tablets) specified in Part II of this Schedule, the quantity for which payment may be made from the Fund pursuant to any one medical prescription shall not exceed a total of 16 doses, or the nearest equivalent manufacturer's original pack available in the market in respect of the original prescription, together with a repeat, if any:

"Provided that, in the case of injections, sufficient for a period not exceeding 72 hours treatment may be allowed,

when necessary:

"(iii) In the case of an extended supply prescription that is ordered for the treatment of a chronic respiratory condition or other condition in which a broad spectrum antibiotic is regarded as the treatment of choice by authoritative medical opinion, payment may be made from the Fund for the prescribed quantity necessary for the treatment of the patient over a period not exceeding three months' treatment, if the amount supplied on any one occasion represents not more than one month's supply.

"(2) Any proprietary topical application other than a preparation that is specified in Part II of this Schedule is not a charge on the Fund. Likewise the quantity (if any) of the following materials, their salts and derivatives, present in any extemporaneously dispensed preparation, being other than a preparation specified in Part II of this Schedule, is not a charge on the Fund:

Chloramphenicol:

Chlortetracycline:

Erythromycin:

Oxytetracycline:

Tetracycline."

- 9. Clause 2 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if—
 - (a) The words "or one repeat" were omitted, and the words "and one repeat" were substituted therefor;
 - (b) The words "(including any such repeat)" were inserted after the word "supply"; and
 - (c) The words "or congenital heart disease" were inserted after the words "rheumatic diseases".
- 10. Clause 3 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the following proviso were added thereto:

"Provided that, in the case of continuation treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words, 'recommended by (*Name of specialist*)' shall be accepted for payment."

- 11. Clause 5 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the words "(being for the purposes of this direction any person who is not an inmate of a public hospital)" were inserted after the words "to an outpatient".
- 12. Clause 6 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the words "(being for the purposes of this direction any person who is not an inmate of a public hospital)" were inserted after the words "to an outpatient".
- 13. Clause 7 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the words "(being for the purposes of this direction any person who is not an inmate of a public hospital)" were inserted after the words "to an outpatient".

- 14. Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the following clauses were inserted after clause 7:
- "7A. 'Hospital Board (dermatological specialist)' means that the material concerned may be supplied by a Hospital Board to a person, who is not the inmate of a public hospital, on the recommendation of a dermatological specialist:

"Provided that, in the case of continuation treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by (Name of specialist)' shall be accepted by a Hospital Board.

"7B. 'Hospital Board (psychiatric specialist)' means that the material concerned may be supplied by a Hospital Board to a person, who is not the inmate of a public hospital or a mental hospital, on the recommendation of a psychiatric specialist:

"Provided that, in the case of continuation treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by (*Name of specialist*)' shall be accepted by a Hospital Board."

15. Clause 14 of Part I of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the following words were added:

"Except where a prescription orders the materials endorsed 'antibiotic restriction' or 'penicillin restriction', the quantity restriction specified in the availability column of the Schedule for other materials relates to each occasion of dispensing, whether the original or the repeat supply (if any)."

- 16. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto included the medicines, drugs, and materials specified in the First Schedule hereto and as if they were available to the extent specified in the said First Schedule.
- 17. The Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if Part II of the Schedule thereto were amended by omitting the items having the code references shown in the first column of the Second Schedule hereto, and substituting the items set out in the said Second Schedule.
- 18. Part II of the Schedule to the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if the items specified in the Third Schedule hereto were omitted.
- 19. The Drug Tariff 1960, Amendment No. 5, is hereby revoked; and the Drug Tariff 1960 shall be read as if this direction were the only amendment thereof that had ever been made.
