

### THE DRUG TARIFF 1970, AMENDMENT NO. 10

Pursuant to the Social Security Act 1964, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following direction.

#### DIRECTION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This direction may be cited as the Drug Tariff 1970, Amendment No. 10, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Drug Tariff 1970\* (hereinafter referred to as the Tariff).
  - (2) This direction shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1973.
- **2. Scope of Tariff**—The Tariff shall be read as if paragraph (g) of the second proviso to clause 3 were revoked, and the following paragraph were substituted:
  - "(g) Lozenges and similar products, other than those (if any) that are specified in Part II of the Schedule to this Tariff:".
- **3. Prices for pharmaceutical requirements**—(1) Clause 5 of the Tariff shall be read as if subclause (1) were revoked and the following subclause were substituted:
- "(1) Subject to clause 18 of this Tariff and to subclause (7) of this clause, payment shall be made in respect of claims for pharmaceutical requirements in accordance with the prices specified in the First Schedule to the Prescription Pricing Schedules and in accordance with the rules for pricing contained in Part II of this Tariff."
- (2) The said clause 5 shall be further read as if the following subclause were added:
- "(7) Notwithstanding anything in subclauses (1) to (6) of this clause, if—
  - "(a) The pharmaceutical requirement is named or described in a circular received by the contractor from the Department of Health and expressed to be issued by direction of the Minister of Health; and
  - "(b) The pharmaceutical requirement is supplied by the contractor on a date within the period in respect of which the circular is expressed to have effect; and
  - "(c) The circular specifies an additional amount to be paid, or a deduction to be made from any amount which would otherwise be payable, in respect of such supply; and

"(d) In the case of any such additional amount, the prescription relating to such supply is endorsed with the letters STC and the figure representing that amount,—

the payment to be made to the contractor, as otherwise calculated in accordance with this Tariff, shall be increased or diminished, as the case may require, by the appropriate sum specified or indicated in the circular."

- **4. Bulk supply orders and medical practitioners' supply orders**—The Tariff shall be read as if clause 15 were revoked and the following clause were substituted:
- "15.—Payment for bulk supply orders and medical practitioners' supply orders shall be computed as follows:
  - (a) Except in the case of any item to which paragraph (d) of this clause applies, the selling price in the First Schedule to the Prescription Pricing Schedules shall be increased by 12½ percent:
  - "(b) In the case of any item listed in the Table of Allowances, the material allowances shall be subject to a discount of 10 percent:
  - "(c) In the case of any item not listed in the Prescription Pricing Schedules, the price charged to the contractor shall be increased by 35 percent, unless the item is an item to which paragraph (d) of this clause applies, in which case the price charged to the contractor shall be increased by no more than 20 percent:
  - "(d) In the case, of allergy treatment sets, insulin preparations, or radiographic preparatory substances, 20 percent shall be added to the price charged to the contractor:
  - "(e) No payment shall be made for containers supplied with materials ordered on a bulk supply order for a hospital or other approved institution unless the order specifies that a pharmaceutical requirement is to be dispensed in metal tubes, dropper bottles, or other approved containers, in which case the appropriate sum specified in the Second Schedule to the Prescription Pricing Schedules, together with the average container allowance specified in that Schedule, shall be paid for those containers:
  - "(f) No payment shall be made for containers supplied with materials ordered on a medical practitioner's supply order unless the pharmaceutical requirement ordered is supplied in a dropper bottle, metal tube, or other approved container, in which case, the appropriate sum specified in the Second Schedule to the Prescription Pricing Schedules, together with the average container allowance specified in that Schedule, shall be paid for those containers:
  - "(g) No payment shall be made for a dispensing fee, except in the case of a pharmaceutical requirement compounded by the contractor. The fee payable shall be that specified in the Third Schedule to the Prescription Pricing Schedules and shall be subject to a discount of 10 percent."
- 5. Claims on the Department—The Tariff shall be read as if the following subclause were added to clause 18:

"(3) For the purposes of this clause,—

'Half-monthly period' means any period beginning with the 1st day and ending with the 15th day, or beginning with the 16th day and ending with the last day, of any month:
"'Monthly period' means a period beginning with the 1st day and

ending with the last day of any month."

6. Payment for intravenous fluids—The Tariff shall be read as if clause 20 were revoked and the following clause were substituted:

"20. Payment to a licensed hospital, medical practitioner, or contractor, in respect of the types of intravenous fluids allowed under the Schedule to this Tariff shall be the amount of the allowance specified from time to time in the Prescription Pricing Schedules or the sum approved from time to time by the Director-General."

7. Payment for irrigating solutions—The Tariff shall be read

as if the following clause were inserted after clause 20:

- "20A. Payment to a licensed hospital or to a medical practitioner in respect of the types of irrigating solutions allowed under the Schedule to this Tariff shall be the amount of the allowance specified from time to time in the Prescription Pricing Schedules or the sum approved from time to time by the Director-General."
- 8. Payment for anaesthetic agents—The Tariff shall be read as if the following clause were inserted after clause 21:
- "21A. Payment to a medical practitioner, in respect of the types of anaesthetic agents specified in the Schedule to this Tariff shall be the amount approved from time to time by the Director-General."
- 9. Period and quantity of supply—(1) Clause 22 of the Tariff shall be read as if subclauses (2) and (3) were revoked and the following subclause were substituted:
- "(2) Notwithstanding anything in subclause (1) of this clause, in any case where the liquid oral form of a pharmaceutical requirement that is an antibiotic is prescribed but requires the addition of a solvent at the time of dispensing, payment shall be made for—
  - "(a) The amount of the pharmaceutical requirement prescribed if that coincides with a standard pack or a number of standard packs; or
  - "(b) The next larger pack or the largest pack, as the case may require, and, if this is not sufficient to satisfy the prescription, such additional pack or packs, containing in the aggregate the smallest quantity of the pharmaceutical requirement, necessary to satisfy the prescription, if the amount prescribed does not coincide with a standard pack or a number of standard packs."
- (2) The said clause 22 shall be read as if the words "or subclause (3)" were omitted from subclause (4), and the words "or subclause (2)" were substituted.
- (3) The said clause 22 shall be read further as if, after subclause (5) the following subclause were inserted:

- "(5A) Notwithstanding anything in subclauses (1) to (5) of this clause, if a quantity greater than that sufficient for 7 days' treatment but less than 1 month's treatment is required, payment may be made for the actual quantity prescribed if the quantity required and not the period for which treatment is required, is stated by the medical practitioner, and if the medical practitioner has endorsed the prescription with the words 'extended supply'."
- 10. Definition of "Anaesthetic agent" added to Part I of Schedule to Tariff—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if the following clause were inserted after clause 1:
- "la. Anaesthetic agent' means that payment shall be made to a medical practitioner who has purchased the pharmaceutical requirement for the purpose of administering an anaesthetic as a general medical service to a patient entitled to receive a benefit in respect of such service."
- 11. Antibiotic and penicillin restrictions—Part 1 of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if clauses 2 and 14 were revoked.
- 12. Definition of "Hospital Board—specialist"—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if clause 6 were revoked and the following clause were substituted:
- "6. 'Hospital Board—specialist' means that the pharmaceutical requirement concerned may be supplied free of charge only by a Hospital Board to any person who is not an inpatient of a public hospital, on the prescription of a specialist, or, if the treatment of any such person with the requirement has been recommended by a specialist, on the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by [name of specialist]'.

"For the purposes of this definition it shall not make any difference whether the specialist is employed by the Board or not."

13. Definition of "Hospital Board—O. and G. specialist"—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if clause 7 were revoked and the following clause were substituted:

"7. 'Hospital Board—O. and G. specialist' means that the pharmaceutical requirement concerned may be supplied free of charge only by a Hospital Board to any person who is not an inpatient of a public hospital, on the prescription of an obstetrical or gynaecological specialist.

"For the purposes of this definition it shall not make any difference whether the specialist is employed by the Board or not."

14. Definition of "Hospital Board—psychiatric specialist" added to Part I of Schedule to Tariff—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if the following clause were inserted after clause 7:

"7A. 'Hospital Board—psychiatric specialist' means that the pharmaceutical requirement concerned may be supplied free of charge only by a Hospital Board to any person who is not an inpatient of a public hospital, on the prescription of a specialist in psychological medicine, or, if the treatment of any such person with the requirement has been recommended by any such specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by [name of specialist]'.

"For the purposes of this definition, it shall not make any difference whether the specialist is employed by the Board or not."

15. Definition of "Intravenous fluids"—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if the word "or" were inserted after paragraph (b) of clause 9 and the following paragraph were added to that clause:

"(c) To a contractor in the respect of the dispensing fee if the requirement is prescribed by a medical practitioner for the use of a patient on a

renal dialysis unit at his own home."

- 16. Definition of "Irrigating Solutions" added to Part I of Schedule to Tariff—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if the following clause were inserted after clause 9:
  - "9A. 'Irrigating solutions' means that payment may be made only—
  - "(a) To a licensed hospital for the treatment of any patient in the hospital (being treatment that has been recommended by a medical practitioner), or if the requirement has been supplied by the hospital to a medical practitioner for the treatment of a patient in his own home; or
  - "(b) To a medical practitioner who has used the requirement for the treatment of a patient either when treating him at a licensed hospital or at his home."
- 17. Definitions of "Radiotherapy specialist" and "Retail pharmacy—specialist" added to Part I of Schedule to Tariff—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if the following clauses were inserted after clause 15:
- "15A. 'Radiotherapy specialist' means that payment may be made only when the pharmaceutical requirement concerned is ordered by a radiotherapy specialist (including the registrar of the appropriate department of a public hospital); but, in the case of treatment recommended by the specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by [name of specialist]' shall be accepted for payment.
- "15B. 'Retail pharmacy—specialist' means that the pharmaceutical requirement concerned may be supplied free of charge by a retail pharmacy on the prescription of a specialist, or, in the case of treatment recommended by a specialist, the prescription of a medical practitioner endorsed with the words 'recommended by [name of specialist]' ".
- 18. Medical Practitioners recognised as specialists—Part I of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if clause 16 were revoked and the following clause were substituted:
- "16. Only those medical practitioners who for the purposes of section 97 of the Social Security Act 1964 (as substituted by section 14 of the Social Security Amendment Act 1969) have been recognised as specialists by the Minister, or, who are specialists for the purposes of any determination issued under section 52 of the Hospitals Act 1957 shall be specialists for the purposes of this Schedule and then only to the extent of the medical or surgical speciality in which they are so recognised".
- 19. Certain pharmaceutical requirements omitted from Part II of Schedule to Tariff—Part II of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if the pharmaceutical requirements specified in the First Schedule to this direction were omitted.

- 20. Certain pharmaceutical requirements added to Part II of Schedule to Tariff—Part II of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if it included the pharmaceutical requirements specified in the Second Schedule to this direction and as if those requirements were available to the extent specified in that Schedule.
- 21. Certain manufacturers added to Part III of Schedule to Tariff—Part III of the Schedule to the Tariff shall be read as if it included the manufacturers named in the Third Schedule to this direction.
- 22. Revocation—The Drug Tariff 1970, Amendment No. 9\*, is hereby revoked; and the Drug Tariff 1970† shall be read as if this direction were the only amendment of the Tariff that had ever been made.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the direction, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This direction amends the Drug Tariff 1970 so as to provide for omissions from and additions to, the list of pharmaceutical requirements in Part II of the Schedule. Omitted items do not in all cases disappear from the list. Certain of them are included with some variation in the Schedule of additions.

Provision is made for a new pricing procedure by way of circulars issued by the direction of the Minister of Health. These enable payment for certain pharmaceutical requirements as calculated according to the Prescription Pricing Schedules to be increased or decreased in accordance with the circular.
