



**THE DENTAL TECHNICIANS REGULATIONS 1968,
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 15th day of March 1982

PURSUANT to section 40 (1) (d) of the Medical and Dental Auxiliaries Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Dental Technicians Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Dental Technicians Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Fee for annual licence—(1) Regulation 16 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 5 of the Dental Technicians Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (4) the expression "\$8", and substituting the expression "\$12".

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 16 (4) of the principal regulations (as amended by subclause (1) of this regulation), the fee for the issue of an annual licence in respect of the year ending with the 31st day of March 1982 shall be \$8.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase the fee payable by a registered dental technician for an annual licence. The fee is increased from \$8 to \$12, although the fee payable for an annual licence issued in respect of the current year (which ends with 31 March 1982) remains at \$8.
