**THE DEFENCE WORKS LABOUR LEGISLATION SUSPENSION
ORDER 1942, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

PURSUANT to the Labour Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940,* the Minister of Labour doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence Works Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1942, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Defence Works Labour Legislation Suspension Order 1942† (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. Clause 3 of the principal Order is hereby amended by omitting the words “ from being employed.”.

3. Clause 9 of the principal Order is hereby amended by adding the words “ and no payment shall be made in respect of any Sunday or holiday or half-holiday except for time actually worked ”.

4. This Order shall come into effect on the day of the date hereof.
