**THE EDUCATION (1993 PRIMARY AND INTERMEDIATE
SCHOOL STAFFING) ORDER 1992, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 91H of the Education Act 1989 and section 25 (j) of the Acts Interpretation Act 1924, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Education (1993 Primary and Intermediate School Staffing) Order 1992, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (1993 Primary and Intermediate School Staffing) Order 1992* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Total staffing entitlements—Clause 12 (1) of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the words “Subject to subclause (2) of this order”, and substituting the words “Subject to subclause (2) of this clause”.

3. Limitations on appointment and employment of other regular teachers at primary institutions—Clause 15 (1) of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the expression “subclause (4)”, and substituting the expression “subclause (3)”.

4. Limitations on appointment and employment of regular teachers in positions of responsibility at normal primary schools—Clause 19 (2) of the principal order is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(d) A senior teacher (special duties) of a grade higher than that specified in the fifth column of the Seventh Schedule to this order opposite the school’s total staffing entitlement; or”.

5. Limitations on appointment and employment of regular teachers in positions of responsibility at normal intermediate schools—Clause 20 (2) of the principal order is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (d), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(d) A senior teacher (special duties) of a grade higher than that specified in the fifth column of the Eighth Schedule to this order opposite the school’s total staffing entitlement; or”.
