PURSUANT to section (1) of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974 and section 3 (7) of the Education Amendment Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Education Amendment Acts Commencement Order 1976.

**2. Commencement of sections 3, 6, and 7 of Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974**—Sections 3, 6, and 7 of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974 shall come into force on the 15th day of March 1976.

**3. Commencement of section 3 of Education Amendment Act 1975**—Section 3 of the Education Amendment Act 1975 shall come into force on the 15th day of March 1976.
