PURSUANT to section (1) of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974 and section 3 (7) of the Education Amendment Act 1975, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Education Amendment Acts Commencement Order 1976.
- 2. Commencement of sections 3, 6, and 7 of Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974—Sections 3, 6, and 7 of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974 shall come into force on the 15th day of March 1976.
- 3. Commencement of section 3 of Education Amendment Act 1975—Section 3 of the Education Amendment Act 1975 shall come into force on the 15th day of March 1976.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order fixes 15 March 1976 as the commencement of sections 3, 6, and 7 of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1974 and section 3 of the Education Amendment Act 1975.
