PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Examination and Certification of Teachers Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Examination and Certification of Teachers Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Diploma in Teaching—Regulation 9 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subparagraph (i) of paragraph (b) of subclause (2), which relates to the Diploma in Teaching, the words “(the examination in the case of each unit consisting of at least two three-hour papers)”.
