ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of December 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Engineering Associates Act 1961, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Engineering Associates Fees Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Engineering Associates Fees Regulations 1971* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Increasing application for registration fee—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the item relating to application for registration under the Act the expression “\$5.00”, and substituting the expression “\$10.00”.

These regulations increase, from \$5 to \$10, the fee payable on application for registration by Engineering Associates.
