ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 14th day of August 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (Terms and Holidays) Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Terms and Holidays) Regulations 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Holidays—Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after subclause (1), the following subclause:

“(1A) Subject to regulation 3 of these regulations, a School Committee that has been authorised in that behalf by the Education Board in whose district its school is situated may from time to time grant holidays for its school, not exceeding a total of 6 half days in any calendar year, on occasions that in its opinion are special occasions warranting the granting of holidays; and in that case the school shall be closed accordingly.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations provide for School Committees that have been authorised by their Education Board to do so to grant holidays (not exceeding six half days in any year) for special occasions.
