**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 16th day of June 1980

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL  
PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (Terms and Holidays) Regulations 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Terms and Holidays) Regulations 1977\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1981.

**2. Interpretation**—(1) Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking the definitions of the expressions “secondary school” and “State primary school”, and substituting the following definition:

“‘Secondary school’ includes a composite school.”

(2) The Composite Schools Regulations 1979† are hereby consequentially amended—

- (a) By omitting from regulation 33 the words “State primary”, and substituting the word “secondary”;
- (b) By revoking regulation 41.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the principal regulations and the Composite Schools Regulations 1979 to provide that as from 1981 the days and terms on which composite schools are open will be those prescribed for secondary schools.
