**THE EDUCATION AMENDING REGULATIONS 1940.**

GALWAY, Governor-General.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 24th day of October, 1940.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, and to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Amending Regulations 1940.

2. The regulations relating to grants in aid of free kindergarten schools made on the 13th day of December, 1927, and published in the *Gazette* of that year on page 3671, are further amended by deleting from clause 3 thereof (as substituted by clause 6 of the Kindergarten Grants Regulations 1937—Serial number 282/1937) the figure and symbol “25s.”, and substituting the symbol and figure “£2”.

3. The regulations relating to incidental expenses of schools made on the 11th day of October, 1920, and published in the *Gazette* of that year on page 2859, are further amended by adding to clause 2 thereof the following paragraph :—

“(g) Fire-insurance premiums on school equipment not provided for by the Government.”

4. The regulations relating to Native schools made on the 23rd day of June, 1931, and published in the *Gazette* of that year on page 1811, are further amended by inserting next after clause 2 thereof the following additional clause :—

“2A. The Minister may establish in connection with any Native school a Native district high school, the secondary department of which shall provide such courses of instruction as are approved from time to time by the Director.”

5. The Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938 (Serial number 1938/111) are further amended by deleting clause 51 thereof (as amended by clause 6 of the Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 2—Serial number 1939/149), and substituting the following:—

“ 51. CERTAIN CLAUSES TO APPLY TO NATIVE SCHOOLS.

“ The provisions of subclause (2) of clause 9 (annual grading) of Section 2 (grading of schools), clause 32 (substitution of assistant masters for assistant mistresses, or *vice versa*), clause 41 (increases in staff), clause 42 (decreases in staff), clause 43 (salary of teacher on increase or decrease of staff), and clause 44 (additional assistants) of Section 5 (mixed schools), Section 10 (intermediate schools and departments), and of Section 11 (district high schools) shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to Native schools.”

6. The Teachers Emergency Regulations 1940 (Serial number 1940/134) are amended by adding next after clause 19 thereof the following additional clause:—

“ 20. Notwithstanding anything in section 97 of the Public Service Superannuation Act, 1927, the period of unemployment of any contributor shall not be deemed to include any period during which the contributor served in New Zealand or overseas with His Majesty's Forces.”

7. Notwithstanding anything contained in clauses 3, 4, 5 (as amended on the 13th day of May, 1930, and published in the *Gazette* of that year on page 1680), and 6 of the regulations relating to examinations in technology made on the 30th day of November, 1928, and published in the *Gazette* of that year on page 3413, the Director may, at his discretion, permit any person who has been accepted for overseas service with any of His Majesty's Forces and who is otherwise eligible to present himself for examination in the intermediate or final grades of the examination relating to the trade or occupation in which such person has been employed.
