



**THE EDUCATION AMENDING REGULATIONS 1944**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 16th day of August, 1944

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Amending Regulations 1944, and shall come into force on the day following the date of publication in the *Gazette* of a notification of the making thereof.

2. (1) Clause 19 of the Education Amending Regulations 1941,\* as amended by clause 5 of the Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3†, is hereby further amended by omitting the reference to "fifteen shillings", and substituting a reference to "seventeen shillings and sixpence".

(2) Clause 5 of the Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3†, is hereby consequentially amended by revoking paragraph (a) thereof.

3. The regulation relating to the issue of Higher Leaving Certificates, contained in clause 3 of the amending regulations made under the Education Act, 1914, by Order in Council dated the 11th day of February, 1935‡, is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) By omitting the words "in English, and four units of a like standard in each of two other subjects", and substituting the words "in each of three subjects"; and
- (b) By inserting the word "English" before the word "Mathematics".
