### THE EDUCATION AMENDING REGULATIONS 1944

# C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 16th day of August, 1944

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Education Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Education Amending Regulations 1944, and shall come into force on the day following the date of publication in the Gazette of a notification of the making thereof.
- 2. (1) Clause 19 of the Education Amending Regulations 1941,\* as amended by clause 5 of the Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3†, is hereby further amended by omitting the reference to "fifteen shillings", and substituting a reference to "seventeen shillings and sixpence ".
- (2) Clause 5 of the Teachers' Salaries Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3†, is hereby consequentially amended by revoking paragraph (a)
- 3. The regulation relating to the issue of Higher Leaving Certificates, contained in clause 3 of the amending regulations made under the Education Act, 1914, by Order in Council dated the 11th day of February, 1935<sup>‡</sup>, is hereby amended as follows:-
  - (a) By omitting the words "in English, and four units of a like standard in each of two other subjects", and substituting the words "in each of three subjects"; and

    (b) By inserting the word "English" before the word "Mathe-
