

# THE EDUCATION (SCHOOL ATTENDANCE) REGULATIONS 1951, AMENDMENT NO. 2

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education (School Attendance) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (School Attendance) Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Boards of Trustees—(1) Regulation 7 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the second proviso (as added by regulation 2 of the Education (School Attendance) Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 1) the words "School Committee", and substituting the

- (2) Regulation 12 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "An Education Board", and substituting the words "A Board of Trustees constituted under the School Trustees Act 1989 or any Act passed in substitution for that Act".
- **3. Secretary of Education**—(1) Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word "Director", in both places where it appears, and substituting, in each case, the words "chief executive of the Ministry".
- (2) Regulation 13 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "Education Board on the form provided by the Director of Education", and substituting the words "chief executive of the Ministry of Education on a form provided by that chief executive".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, make miscellaneous amendments to the Education (School Attendance) Regulations 1951 to take account of the statutory amendments due to take effect on 1 October 1989.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936. Date of notification in *Gazette:* 2 November 1989. These regulations are administered in the Ministry of Education.
