ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of May 1961

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 56 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "and Class C", and substituting the words "Class C, and Class D".

3. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules thereto, as substituted by regulation 13 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 1, and substituting the First and Second Schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1960.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957. They prescribe new salary scales for teachers and provide for Class D positions of responsibility.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.

Date of notification in *Gazette*: 18 May 1961.

These regulations are administered in the Department of Education.
