**THE EDUCATION (SALARIES AND STAFFING) REGULATIONS
1957, AMENDMENT NO. 5**

BERNARD FERGUSSON, Governor-General

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 12th day of April 1966

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 36 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (2), after the word "additional", the word "full-time".

3. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First and Second Schedules, as substituted by regulation 7 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 4, and substituting the First and Second Schedules set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Regulation 7 of, and the First Schedule to, the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 4, are hereby consequentially revoked.

(3) This regulation shall be deemed to have come into force on the 26th day of August 1964.

4. The Eleventh Schedule to the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 8 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 4, is hereby amended by inserting, in the appropriate order, under the heading "Special Educational and Other Specialist Services", the following additional position of responsibility:
"Teacher of Adjustment Classes Scale III B".

5. The Intermediate Schools and Departments Regulations 1932, Amendment No. 5†, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe revised salary scales. *Clause 2* amends regulation 36 of the principal regulations so as to ensure that, where additional full-time or part-time assistants are appointed to meet special needs of a school, only full-time assistants so appointed are to be deemed to be permanently appointed. *Clause 5* revokes certain spent regulations.
