PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Classification of Schools—Regulation 20 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2), as substituted by regulation 3 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 8, the words "Every school and department to which this Part of these regulations applies, other than the secondary department of a district high school," and substituting the words "Every full primary school, contributing school, intermediate school, and intermediate department".

3. Substitution of Schedule—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the Third Schedule, as substituted by regulation 12 of the Education (Salaries and Staffing) Regulations 1957, Amendment No. 8, and substituting the Third Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations vary the existing provisions governing the classification of schools. A new Schedule is substituted for the existing Third Schedule to the regulations containing these provisions.
