**THE SECONDARY AND TECHNICAL INSTITUTE TEACHERS

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Secondary and Technical Institute Teachers Disciplinary Regulations 1969, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondary and Technical Institute Teachers Disciplinary Regulations 1969*.

2. Preliminary investigation of complaint—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by adding the following sub-clause:

“(3) There shall be paid to the person so appointed or to members of the subcommittee set up, out of money appropriated by Parliament for the purpose, remuneration by way of fees, and travelling allowances and expenses, in accordance with the Fees and Travelling Allowances Act 1951, and the provisions of that Act shall apply accordingly, and the person so appointed or the subcommittee so set up shall be a statutory Board within the meaning of that Act.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations enable fees, travelling allowances, and expenses to be paid to any person, or the member of any subcommittee, appointed under regulation 4 of the principal regulations.
