

# THE EARTHQUAKE AND WAR DAMAGE REGULATIONS 1956, AMENDMENT NO. 1

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of October 1962

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Earthquake and War Damage Act 1944, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

# REGULATIONS

- 1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Earthquake and War Damage Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Earthquake and War Damage Regulations 1956\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of May 1962 and shall apply to claims in respect of any loss or damage which occurred on or after that date.
  - 2. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended—
  - (a) By omitting from subclause (5) of clause 21 the figures "£10", and substituting the figure "£5":
  - (b) By omitting from subclause (5) of clause 24 the figures "£10", and substituting the figure "£5".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations reduce the minimum franchise under the Earthquake and War Damage Regulations 1956 from a minimum of £10 to a minimum of £5.
