



**THE EDUCATION BOARDS ADMINISTRATION
REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of September 1968

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Education Boards Administration Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Boards Administration Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Appointment and election of members—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 33, the following regulation:

“33A. Where anything connected with the election of members is omitted to be done or cannot be done at or by the time prescribed by these regulations or is done after that time, or is otherwise irregularly done in matter of form, the Minister may, at any time before or after the time at or by which the thing is required to be done, extend the time for doing the thing to such further time as he thinks fit, or may validate anything so done after the time required or so irregularly done in matter of form, as he thinks fit.”

3. Returns of outstanding revenue—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 39, the following heading and regulation:

“Returns of Outstanding Revenue

“39A. The Chief Executive Officer of the Board shall make returns to the Board of the amounts of revenue due and payable to the Board which are unpaid. Returns shall be made in such form and at such times as the Board may direct, but at least one return in every year shall be made not later than the 30th day of April in respect of amounts outstanding at the end of the previous financial year which are still unpaid at the date when the return is made.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations enable the Minister to cure defects in procedure in connection with the election of members of Education Boards by granting extensions of time, or by validating things irregularly done in matter of form. They also require the Chief Executive Officer of each Education Board to make returns to the Board of outstanding revenue.
