ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of November 1978

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Education Boards Administration Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Boards Administration Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Extraordinary Vacancies—Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word “fiftieth” and substituting the expression “70th”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

These regulations extend the time within which an election to fill an extraordinary vacancy on an Education Board must be held from 50 to 70 days.
